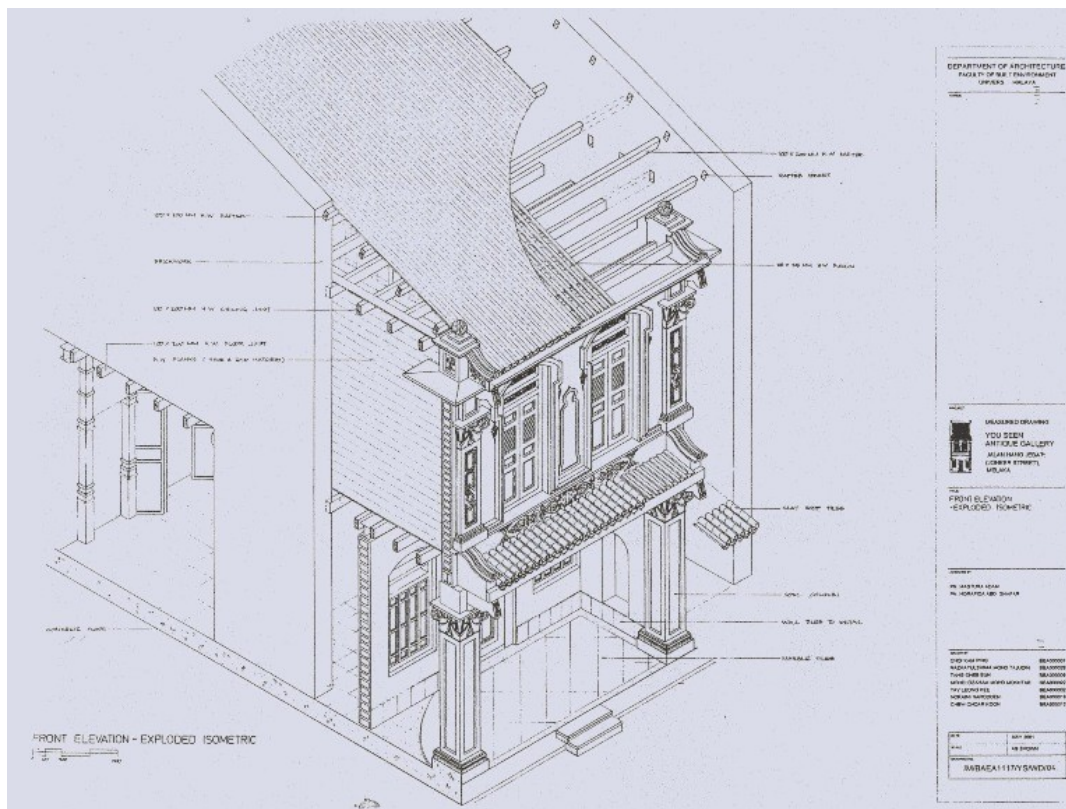

# **MUBIN SHEPPARD MEMORIAL PRIZE INAUGURAL MEASURED DRAWINGS GRANT 2007**

## **THE GRANT**

Badan Warisan Malaysia (BWM) is delighted to announce the launch of the Mubin Sheppard Memorial Prize (MSMP) Measured Drawings Grant 2007. This Grant has been introduced as an extension of the Mubin Sheppard Memorial Prize to encourage measured drawings of heritage buildings which are endangered or in remote locations.

## **OBJECTIVES**

- To encourage a comprehensive preparation of measured drawings which include detailed building analyses, dilapidation studies and working specifications, including historical research and documentation.
- To encourage documentation of lesser known or endangered heritage buildings through measured drawings.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The MSMP Inaugural Measured Drawings Grant is only for Measured Drawings of buildings. A preliminary list of buildings has been prepared by BWM and can be accessed on our website. Proposals of alternative buildings may be submitted for consideration by the Panel of Judges. A clear rationale of 200-300 words accompanied with relevant photographs of the building to be measured must be submitted for all proposals.
2. Application is open to full-time students at any recognized tertiary institution in Malaysia which have an Architectural Programme. The applications must be submitted by the institution of study and not the individuals.
3. Application forms must be accompanied by :
  - a. A brief project proposal outlining project schedule, manpower and a budget which is inclusive of all expenses
  - b. The Head of Department or Dean must recommend the proposal and confirm the applicant's ability to execute the project. Please prepare the recommendation letter with signature and official institution stamp.
4. The project must have a faculty supervisor who will be required to submit one interim progress report to BWM mid-way through the project.
5. The Grant is only to be used to cover students' costs and not costs incurred by supervisory staff or faculty members.

6. A maximum of 3 Grants are available in 2007. The decision of the Panel of Judges is final. BWM reserves the right not to award the Grant.
7. The maximum value of each Grant is RM10,000.
8. Successful applicants will receive an advance payment of 40% of the quantum awarded. The remainder payment will only be disbursed upon satisfactory completion of the Measured Drawings and submission to BWM, as deemed fit by the Panel of Judges.
9. All projects must be completed within 6 months from the date of the Grant award.
10. The Measured Drawings carried out for the project will be considered for the subsequent cycle for the MSMP competition. The applicant is responsible for getting the owner's permission to measure the selected building.
11. The final complete Measured Drawings under this Grant must be submitted to BWM together with:
  - a. 1 soft copy of the drawings in CD;
  - b. 1 digital copy of all drawings, photographs and report on CD;
  - c. A complete report which includes case studies, historical background, architecture, construction & material and details of the drawings. The report can be either in Bahasa Malaysia or English;
  - d. Sketches;
  - e. Digital images which include photographic survey of the building;
  - f. Log book which contains activities and persons in-charge.
12. If the Measured Drawings project is not completed within the stipulated time frame, BWM reserves the right to withdraw the award and to be reimbursed for all or part of the allocation of the payments which has already been disbursed.
13. All submissions under this Grant will remain the property of BWM with the copyright jointly shared by BWM and the respective institutions.
14. BWM reserves the right to impose any other conditions on the Grant as it may deem fit.
15. **Applications close on Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2007 at 5.00 p.m. (Extended to the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2007). The results will be announced through BWM's website on Monday, 2 April 2007.**

## **BADAN WARISAN MALAYSIA**

Badan Warisan Malaysia (BWM) or Heritage of Malaysia Trust is a tax exempt charity set up in 1983 to conserve Malaysia's built heritage and areas of architectural interest in all parts of the country.

In 1995, BWM restored and adapted a 1925 colonial bungalow at No 2 Jalan Stonor into a Heritage Centre with exhibition, seminar, specialist library and meeting facilities. In the grounds of the Heritage Centre is a restored traditional Malay house, Rumah Penghulu Abu Seman, which was relocated from its original site in Kedah and restored in 1996-97 as a premier example of a traditional Kedah Malay house. It functions as a cultural and educational exhibit.

In 2002-2003, BWM undertook a model restoration of a late 18<sup>th</sup> century shophouse at 8 Heeren Street, Malacca, to promote good conservation practice. This site is now open to the public as a heritage and interpretative centre.

## **MUBIN SHEPPARD MEMORIAL PRIZE**

The Mubin Sheppard Memorial Prize (MSMP) was set up to honour the memory of the late Tan Sri Dato' Dr Haji Mubin Sheppard. It was first launched on 8 Feb 1996. It aims to stimulate students' awareness of, and research into, the conservation of Malaysia's built heritage. Between March 1997 and February 2006, six cycles of the competition have been completed.

Tan Sri Mubin Sheppard was a founder member of BWM and Sahabat Warisan Malaysia (Friends of the Heritage of Malaysia Trust), which was a society set up in 1984 to support BWM in its objectives. The initial funding for the MSMP was a culmination of one of Sahabat Warisan's fundraising efforts. In 1995 Sahabat Warisan was dissolved and its membership merged with BWM's.

The late Tan Sri had a distinguished career serving both the Colonial and the Malaysian government. His deep love for history, culture and his fellow Malaysians is reflected in his founding of the National Archives, the National Museum and the Muslim Welfare Organization of Malaysia.
